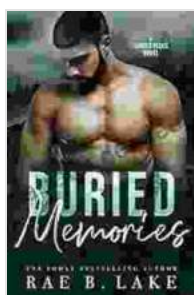

"I love you too," Sarah said. "But we can't be together. It's too dangerous."

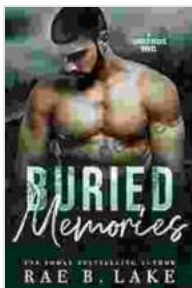
"I'll protect you," Jake said. "I won't let anything happen to you."

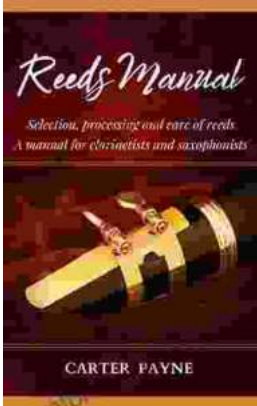
